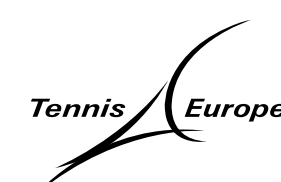

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The tournament is sanctioned by the Lawn Tennis Association (LTA) and the International Tennis Federation (ITF) and will be run under the present Rules of Tennis and the ITF Regulations for the Organisation of Seniors Tournaments and the Code of Conduct as shown in the current ITF Seniors Regulations.
- Every GB competitor in a singles event must be a member of British Tennis and have a current National Rating.
- Only those competitors who have, or will have, reached the minimum age for the event on or before the 31 December 2010 are eligible to compete.
- Competitors may enter **only two events** from one singles, one doubles and one mixed doubles. **All** competitors must submit an entry form, together with the correct entry fees. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason. Plate events will be arranged subject to court availability.
- Matches will be the best of three sets, tie break at 6-6 in all sets for singles; for doubles a Championship Tie Break will replace the 3rd set. The Committee reserves the right to use abbreviated scoring in the event of bad weather.
- The Ladies and Men's Singles 35 and 40 will be played on weekdays from 5.00 pm.** All other events will be played during the day. **All** finals will be played on Sunday 19 September. Should any events be oversubscribed, the Committee reserves the right to schedule some matches on Tuesday, 14 September.
- Play will be on 4 cushioned acrylic, 2 porous acrylic and 8 all-weather courts. Competitors may be required to play under floodlights.
- ITF approved tennis balls will be used.
- Competitors must wear recognised tennis clothing and shoes.
- Entries must reach the Tournament Secretary by **Monday 6 September**. No telephone or late entries will be accepted.
- The draw will be made on Wednesday 8 September. Entry fees will not be refunded after the draw has been made. The Committee reserves the right to merge events should this be deemed necessary.
- The Draw and Order of Play will be posted on the Club's website on Sunday 12 September. Entries will be confirmed by email after the draw. It is the competitor's responsibility to ascertain the time of his/her first match, either by checking the website or phoning the Referee (01202 480826 or Mobile: 07761 464896) after Sunday, 12 September.
Only players without access to website/email should send a self-addressed envelope stamped for first class mail to receive notification of their first match.
- All competitors must sign the attendance sheet on arrival. Any competitor who is absent when required to play may be scratched. Competitors should check with the Referee the time of their next match before leaving the premises.
- Competitors should take all necessary precautions to minimise his/her own risk and is solely responsible for any loss, damage, personal injury or death suffered by him/her caused to other parties as a result of any act, defect, neglect or omission by him/herself.
- In all matters the decision of the Tournament Committee is final. No complaint relating to the tournament can be entertained by the Committee unless lodged in writing with the Tournament Secretary within 48 hours of the cause of complaint.
